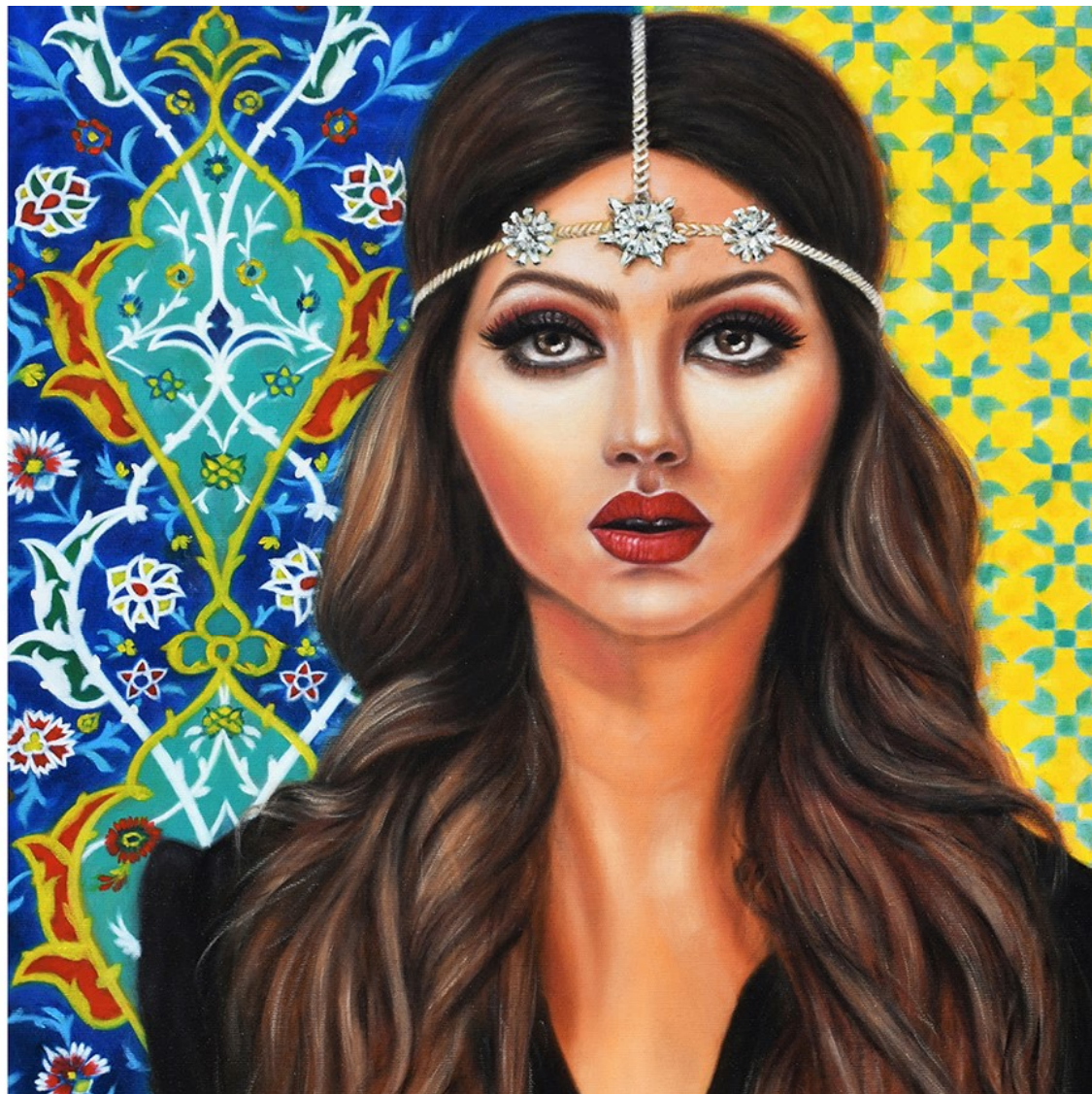

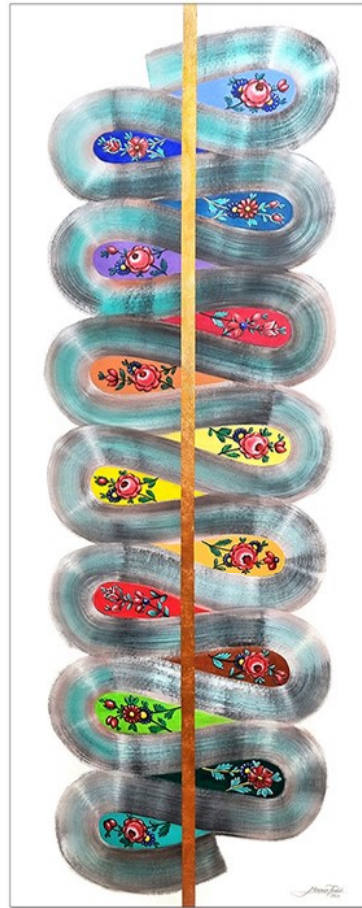
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In The Realm of Colors

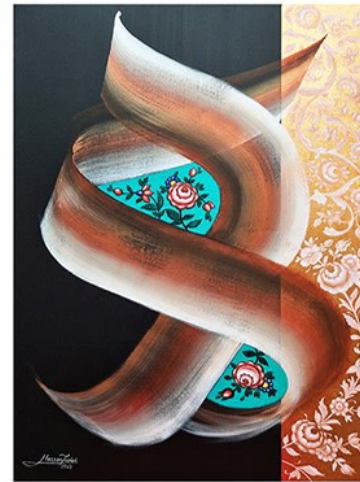

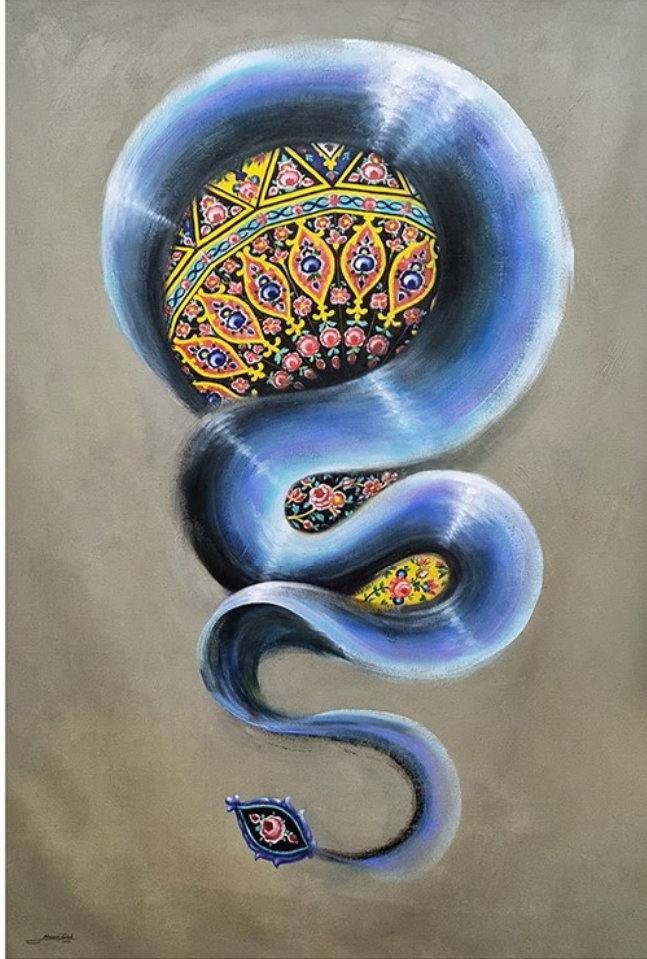

And as I move o'er land and sea, I trace Those paths where you have walked or danced with grace. I find in laughing streams and garden's dreams Eternal signs of your immortal face.

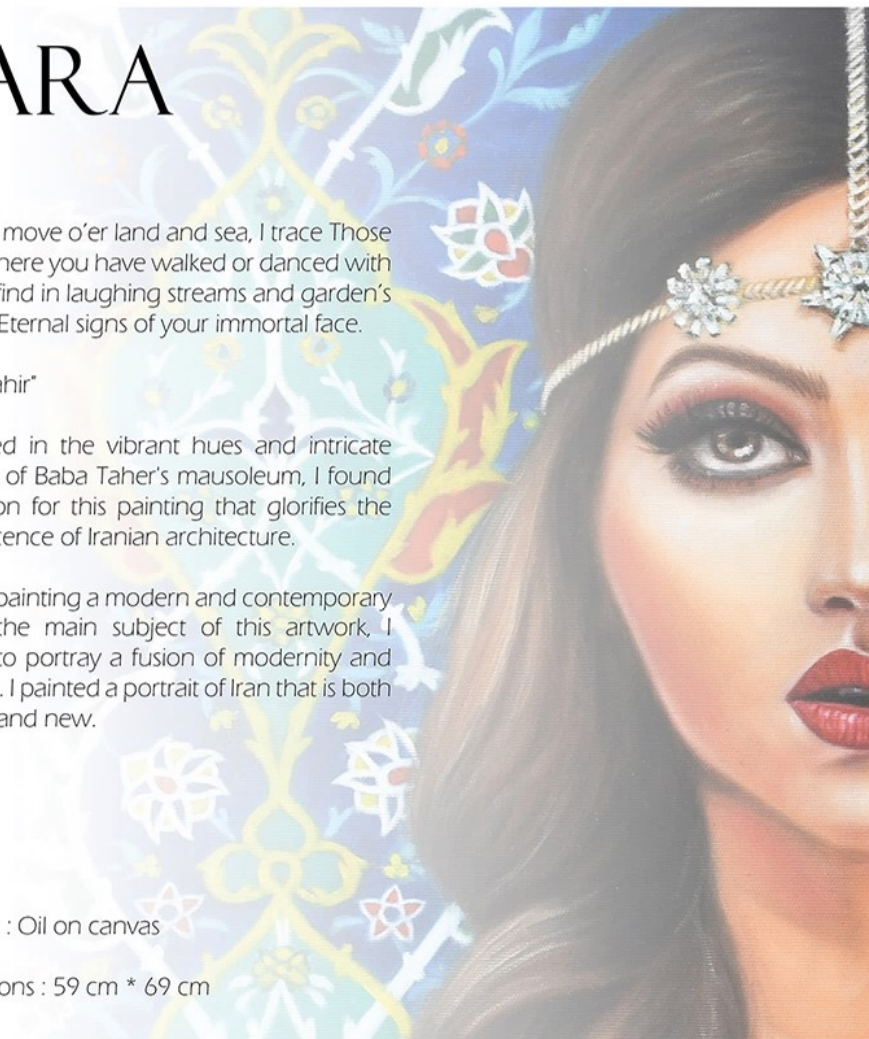
"Baba Tahir"

They firmly believe that there is only one step left to freedom.

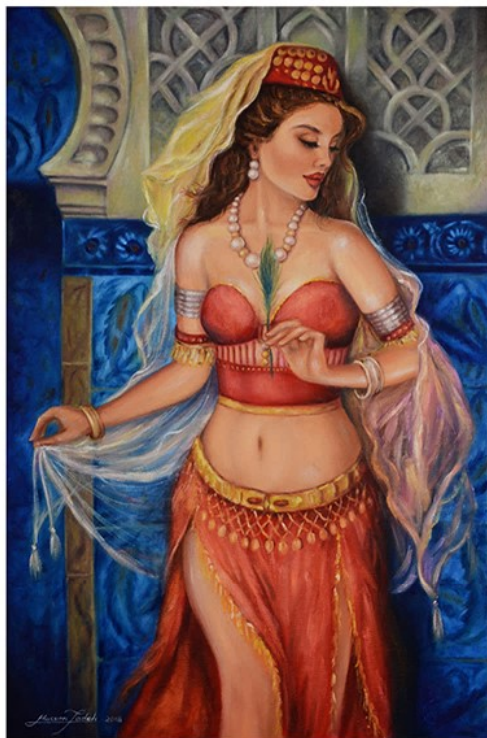
I deeply dedicate this series of paintings to all kindhearted mothers.

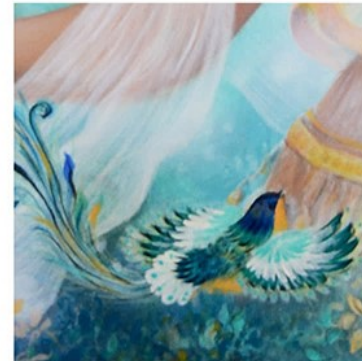
